Gairdner Presentation - From Embryos to Stem Cells and Back Again: A Developmental Journey Tuesday, October 20th (9:00 - 10:00 am)

- Join a live presentation from Dr. Janet Rossant, world-renowned expert in developmental biology and Gairdner Foundation's President and Scientific Director.
- Widely known for her studies of the genes that control embryonic development in the mouse, Rossant has pioneered techniques for following cell fate and altering genes in embryos. Her current research focuses on stem cell development and cell differentiation in the developing embryo, essential areas for the study of birth defects and regenerative medicine.


